"Nitelikli eğitim", herkes için kapsayıcı ve eşitlikçi nitelikli eğitim sağlanması ve ömür boyu eğitim fırsatlarının teşvik edilmesine yönelik küresel amaçtır. Gelişmekte olan bazı bölgelerde ağır yoksulluk, silahlı çatışmalar ve diğer acil krizler nedeniyle, eğitimde ilerleme kaydetmek oldukça zor olmuştur. Batı ve Kuzey Afrika'da devam eden silahlı çatışmalar, okula giden çocuk sayısında azalmaya yol açmıştır. Herkes için kapsayıcı ve nitelikli eğitimin başarılması, eğitimin sürdürülebilir kalkınma için en güçlü ve denenmiş araçlardan biri olduğuna dair inancı yeniden vurgular. 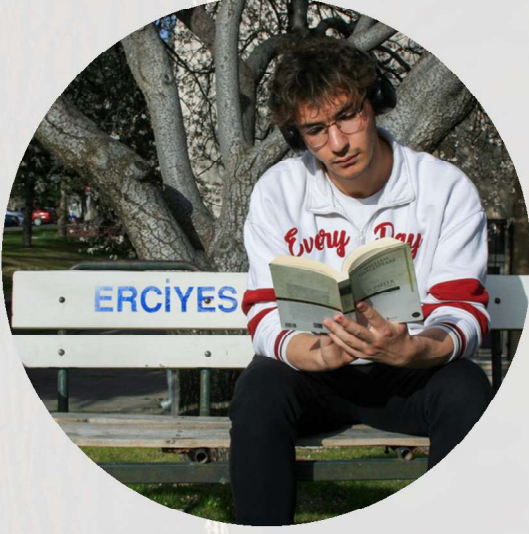
